Grand Opening of Dr Gray's Hospital Clinical Skills Centre (CSC) This new facility represents a significant milestone in our commitment to excellence in patient care and staff development in Moray. Success of pioneering AI study in Grampian We've previously shared information about our participation, along with the University of Aberdeen, in a trial of Mia, an artificial intelligence tool used to closely examine mammograms. The study involved more than 10,000 patients, with results suggesting it helped clinical teams detect 12% more cancers, while reducing workload by almost one third. This is being covered across the BBC today; thanks must go to the clinical team and our patient case study Barbara for their willingness to support filming.
