Autumn vaccination programme – staff clinics This year's 'flu/COVID-19 vaccination programme gets underway this Monday (4 September). Previous users of the online booking system will receive either a text message or email this week with a reminder of your username; the password can be easily reset on the site if you don't remember it. As well as the option to book into the main vaccination centres, dedicated staff clinics have been arranged. Dates, times, and locations for Aberdeen City and Aberdeenshire are below. Please note, clinics highlighted in green for Aberdeen are walk-in; all the clinics listed below in Aberdeenshire are walk-in. We would encourage you to book appointments wherever possible; walk-in clinics have been arranged to support those of you who need the flexibility of a walk-in clinic. These clinics may be particularly busy; it is possible you will be asked not to join the queue at peak times, but to come back later.

Please ensure you have your staff ID badge with you when attending staff clinics.
