Migraine management Improving Migraine Management in NHS Grampian's Community Pharmacies is a partnership project between us and The Migraine Trust. The project aims to:

- improve recognition, diagnosis and management of migraine by community pharmacy teams
- promote public awareness of what community pharmacy teams can offer to support migraine management, and encouraging people to have a conversation with their pharmacy team if they have or think they might have migraine
- promote public awareness of migraine and trustworthy self-help resources.
