
COOND-19Brief

Here is the brief for Friday 28 May 2021.

COVID-19 – new vaccine approved The Medicines & Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) have today approved a fourth COVID-19 vaccine for use in the UK. The new jab, developed by Janssen, involves a single dose. 20 million doses have been ordered and are expected to arrive in the UK later this year. Grampian data The local figures for today and the 7-day rolling positivity rate are shown below. As a reminder, this rate is arrived at by dividing the number of positive tests in the past 7 days by the number of tests carried out in the past 7 days. Repeat tests are included in both categories, whereas the figures we show here only record new tests.

Dementia Awareness Week 2021 This annual event gets underway from Monday (31 May) with the theme of 'Hidden Voice, Hidden Impact, Hidden Cost: Let's Talk About Dementia'. We'll have much more on this next week, but we wanted to kick things off by introducing the 'Getting to Know Me' (GTKM) personal profile tool. This was created by the National Dementia Consultant network, consisting of Alzheimer Scotland Dementia Nurse Consultants and AHP Dementia Consultants in Scotland, in conjunction with the Scottish Government and people with dementia. It is a nationally available and recognised tool which can aid and support person-centred care. The GTKM can be instrumental in providing key information to support people with a diagnosis of dementia during a stay in hospital.
