

Infection Prevention & Control training – what do I need to do? All members of NHS Grampian staff are expected to complete Infection Prevention & Control training, but the package you should undertake will vary depending on your role. The IPC team have created this flow chart to make it easy for you. Digital Ward – Discharge Tab test of change A new Discharge Tab provides a dedicated space within TrakCare for clinicians to work collaboratively in facilitating timely discharge for each patient – with the aim of alleviating the high numbers of delayed discharges we face, with many people who are medically fit for discharge still waiting in hospital. Discharge Planning can be a complex process; we are hopeful that the Discharge Tab will support clinicians in identifying potentially complex discharges at point of admission.

The discharge tab is being tested, from today, in Ward 102 ARI, Ward 7 Dr Grays and Donbank ward in Inverurie community hospital. If the patient involved in the test of change transitions to a non-test of change ward, or you are a visiting clinician without test of change access in TrakCare, please see guidance on accessing the discharge from here. 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iMatter 2023 is almost here. iMatter gives you the chance to share how it feels for you to work as part of a team, with your manager, and in NHS Grampian, Aberdeen City, Aberdeenshire or Moray HSCPs. Teams use the anonymous results to work together, focusing on three things to really make a difference to their day-to-day experiences, as well as recognising what is working well for them. Managers will be asked to confirm who is in their team on the iMatter system from next Monday (24 April). Teams should be confirmed on the system by 18 May at 5pm. Managers, you need to do this, otherwise your team will not receive their questionnaires on the 22 May. We will be sending managers information on team confirmation by email this week.
