New Mortuary to be developed A new £30m mortuary is to be built for the north-east and Northern Isles. The new premises will provide dignity for the deceased, improved facilities for bereaved families, and support growth in the scope and nature of locally provided forensic and educational activity. Led by ourselves and Aberdeen City Council, the new facility at the Foresterhill Health Campus will be a comprehensive, multi-purpose mortuary serving the needs of NHS Grampian, University of Aberdeen, the Crown Office Procurator Fiscal Service, Police Scotland, and Aberdeen City, Aberdeenshire, Moray, Orkney, and Shetland Island Councils. The new two-storey mortuary facility is to be built adjacent to the greenfield site next to Foresterhill Health Centre and will be an integrated post-mortem examination facility and storage for the deceased that will offer mortuary services within a single facility to serve the population of the North-east of Scotland and Northern Isles. This new structure will also include teaching, learning, and training facilities on the upper floor, provide more privacy and dignity in the bereavement suites, and make the most of natural light opportunities in the clinical, circulation and office space areas. The design and construction will meet the ambitions of being a net zero carbon facility.
