DGH statement Following discussions on the Moray Maternity Plan in the Scottish Parliament yesterday, NHS Grampian is committed to the delivery of a safe and sustainable maternity service for Moray families and staff. We are fully focussed to putting local needs at the heart of a wider and changing health system. We continue to engage with the Scottish Government, mothers, communities and colleagues within NHS Grampian and NHS Highland to ensure our joint implementation plan is robust and practical.

Work is well underway on the development of a plan to deliver Model 6, a full obstetric service based in Dr Gray's Hospital, which will be announced before the end of the year in line with the Scottish Government's timeline. We look forward to working with the community and our partners as we cocreate and implement these plans.

Clinical Biochemistry Referral Sample Handling During Postal Strike The Clinical Biochemistry Department sends a large number of samples to referral labs for specialist testing via Royal Mail. Royal Mail has scheduled further strike action throughout October and November. The 1-day strikes planned in October will have minimal impact, however the impacts will be felt in November, as there are few consecutive days without strikes to allow posting of samples with next day delivery.
