



# Important Legal Information

## Read this before copying – ensure you comply with copyright law

- one entire case from a published report of judicial proceedings
- one complete chapter from a book
- or 5% of the publication if greater than the above.

Copies may be distributed to members of a Designated Committee set up by your organisation, which includes consultants who have an advisory, consultative, tribunal or executive function in connection with your organisation's activities.

Patients, and carers or guardians of patients may be provided with a single Paper Copy in connection with their treatment and/or condition.

You may take as many copies as required for a single purpose providing the publication is not listed in the CLA List of Excluded Categories and Works displayed nearby (or see [www.cla.co.uk](http://www.cla.co.uk)) and provided the publication is published in the Mandating Territories listed in the User Guidelines.
