Health and Care (Staffing) (Scotland) Act 2019 - new SharePoint site launched The Health and Care (Staffing) (Scotland) Act took effect on 1 April 2024. A new SharePoint site has been developed locally to help facilitate and enable teams across the organisation understand the requirements within the legislation and their roles and responsibilities. It includes an overview of each of the duties within the Act, useful links and learning resources, as well as information on our reporting requirements. The first Annual Report on our compliance against the Act was endorsed by Grampian NHS Board in April 2025, prior to its submission to Scottish Government.

A summary version of the Annual Report was developed to be shared widely with our colleagues and citizens, to support communication of key achievements, challenges and areas of focus for NHS Grampian in the first year of implementation and beyond.
