Take care when emailing groups The UK's Information Commissioner urges all healthcare providers to be aware of the risks of sending group emails following incidents in organisations providing support to people with HIV. They recommend group emails are not sent, even using 'BCC', following cases where the 'CC' field was used by mistake. People were identified as having conditions or vulnerabilities because they were receiving general support or information, rather than the direct disclosure of their health data.

If you're emailing a group about something sensitive and potentially disclosive, for example information around mental or sexual health support, or support for a specific condition like HIV, consider whether it's appropriate to send via email. Remember families may share email accounts and devices. If it is appropriate to send an email, send the information to people individually (one sender-one recipient). Do not send a group email, even if it is 'BCC'.

Turas Learn System Notification Developers at NHS Education for Scotland (NES) are currently investigating an issue within the Turas Learn system whereby some recently completed courses are incorrectly appearing as requiring renewal. In the interim, if a course is marked as "Completed" in your learning history, no further action is required - even if it appears under the "Requires Renewal" section.
