Staff 'flu clinics – new date added A reminder our staff 'flu clinics begin next week. You can see the complete list under 'Latest News' on the intranet, but we wanted to draw your attention to a new date added in Aberdeen; this coming Wednesday, Woodend Hospital (Ward 17), between 9.30am-4pm, by appointment or drop-in.

Windows 11 Upgrade – automatic rollout to begin on Monday Thank you to everyone who has already taken advantage of the optional Windows 11 upgrade via the pop-up notification or desktop icon. Your proactive approach is helping us move towards a more secure and modern digital environment. As we approach the end of support for Windows 10, it's essential we ensure all devices are up to date and protected. Starting on Monday (1 September) compatible devices which have not been upgraded already will be upgraded automatically. What to expect:

- The upgrade will download in the background.
- It will be applied on the next reboot, with no user interaction required.
- If you wish to keep control over when your device upgrades, we strongly recommend using the **optional upgrade prompt** before your device is automatically updated.

Devices or software identified or reported as incompatible will not be included in this phase of the rollout. These will be addressed separately at a later date. ED discharge letters to GPs The temporary delay in the electronic transmission of ED discharge letters to GPs—within the newly implemented Scottish Edition ED module in TrakCare—has been successfully resolved. All authorised letters will automatically be sent to the patient's GP electronically so will only need to be printed if a copy is required for someone else.
