**Chief Executive Drop-in Session** As mentioned in the last *Ask Laura* video, our new Chief Executive, Laura Skaife-Knight, will be hosting a very informal drop-in session at Dr Gray's canteen between 12.30pm and 1.30pm on Friday, January 30. **Heating Update – Ashgrove House, Foresterhill House & Annex** A major issue with the steam pipe feeding Ashgrove House has required our teams to isolate the supply for safety. This affects Ashgrove House, Foresterhill House, and the Annex. Colleagues are actively working on a permanent fix for the steam pipe issue.

**Temporary one-way road system** To allow for essential works to the Baird Family Hospital, the west (outgoing) side of the main Emergency Department access road, will be closed from Monday, February 2, until Thursday, February 5. There will be no entry to ED from Cornhill Road or Westburn Road.

**Speciality Doctor/Dentists/Services and Medical Managers Career Progression** [This circular](#) provides updated policy guidance for the Career Progression/Regrading of Specialist Doctor/Dentist to Speciality Grade for all medical and dental staff.

In summary, where a Speciality Doctor or Dentist demonstrates that they possess and consistently apply the skills and experience required for the Specialist grade, and a service need for such a post exists, they may progress to the Specialist grade provided all conditions of the circular are met.

This policy is effective from August 1, 2025. Pay should be backdated to then, for candidates who submit their application before February, 2026, and are successful in the process. Please note that the extension to the timescale noted in the circular has been agreed in partnership through BMA LNC to ensure both Speciality Doctors and Managers have the necessary time to consider any requests.

It should be noted this policy does not cover or replace the process to be followed in the event of competitive recruitment into a vacancy role.
