How to get here

The X-Ray Department is in the Inverurie Health and Care Hub on the Inverurie Hospital Site, Upperboat Road, Inverurie. There are maps on page 6 and on the back cover of this leaflet.

On foot

There are 3 new paved walkways from Kellands Park giving direct access to the new Inverurie Health and Care Hub building.

By car

The Inverurie Health and Care Hub is accessed from the main entrance on Upperboat Road. Upperboat Road is approached from St James's Place or Nether Davah Way. See map on page 6.

There is a large car park at the front of the building, which also has multiple disabled spaces, and covered bicycle stands.

By bus

Route number 22 operates within Inverurie and travels one-way along St. James's Place and Upperboat Road for the Inverurie Health and Care Hub and Inverurie Hospital.

Aberdeenshire Council run the **Inverurie Town A2B Dial-a-Bus** Service. This service is for local residents who don't live on a main bus route and those who can't use other buses due to limited mobility. The service operates within Inverurie from 9.30am to 2.15pm on Mondays to Fridays.

The council also run the **Ready2Go bus service in Inverurie and surrounding area**. This "on demand" service runs Monday to Friday 6.30am to 7.30pm and Saturday 7.30am to 6.30pm.

Please report to Reception 2 which is on your right as you enter the Health and Care Hub Building.

You will then be asked to take a seat in the X-ray waiting area. You should be attended to within 30 minutes of your appointment time.

The examination

Your examination will be carried out by a qualified radiographer.

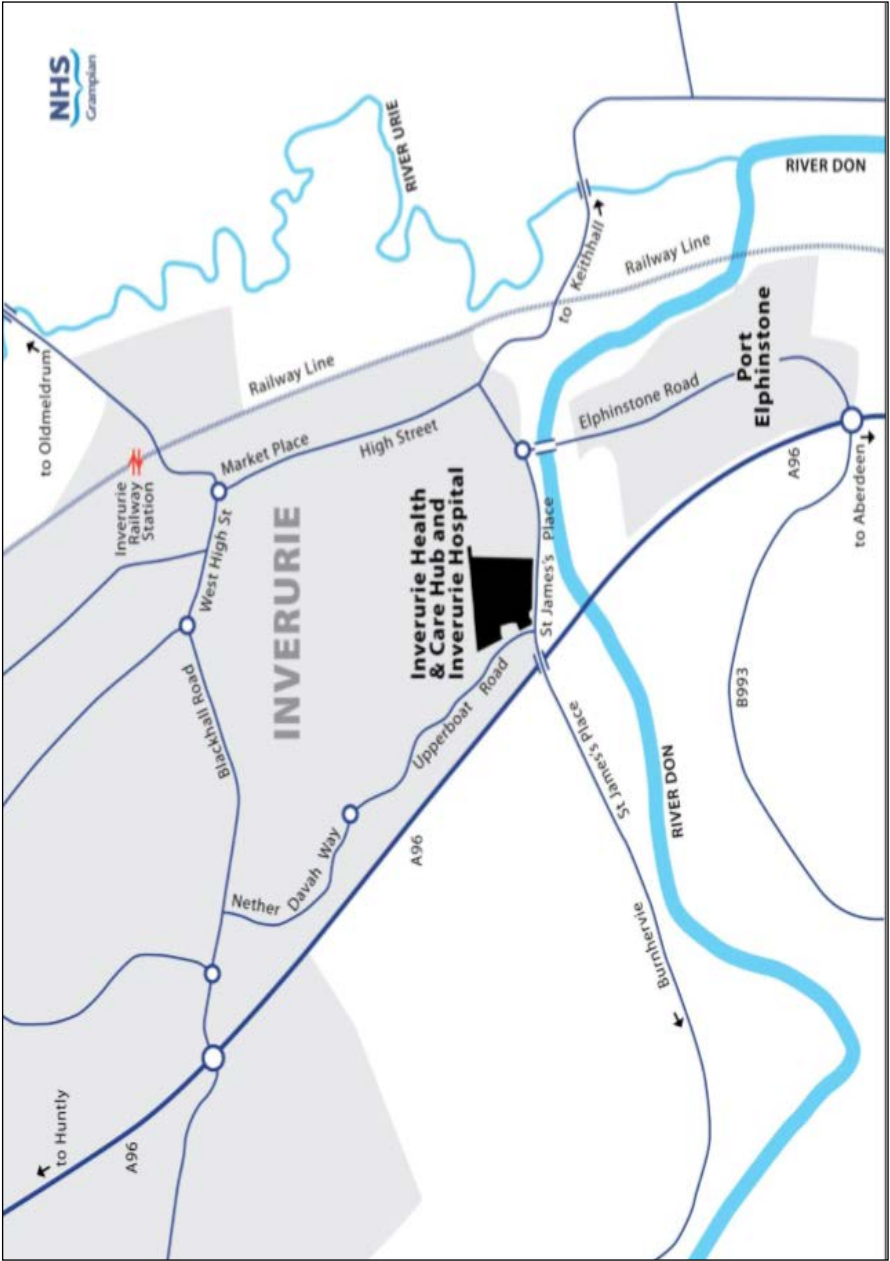
You may be asked to change into a hospital gown for your X-ray, and your examination should take from 5 to 20 minutes.

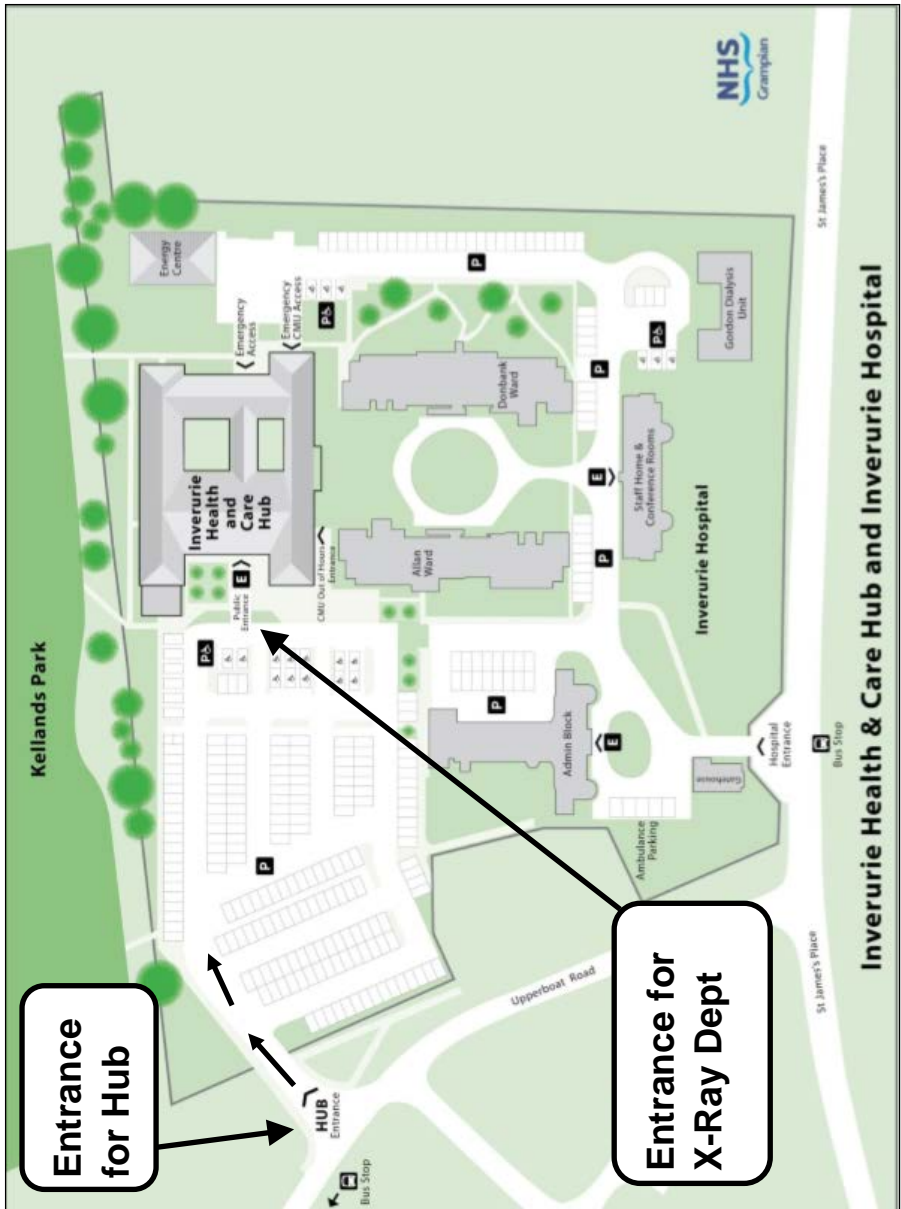
How do I get my results?

Your images will be studied in greater detail by a radiologist (X-ray doctor). The results will be sent to the doctor requesting your examination, which may take up to 10 days. This may be your hospital doctor or your GP.
