
Temporary Closure of normal access route to the Emergency Department at ARI and RACH

April 2022

Public Vehicle & Pedestrian Access

Due to essential construction work, we are preparing for the installation of a link bridge connecting the new Baird Family Hospital to Aberdeen Royal Infirmary (ARI) and Royal Aberdeen Children's Hospital (RACH).

To allow for this link to be made we must temporarily close the normal access route to the Emergency Department (ED) (also known as Accident and Emergency A&E) entrance, accessed from Foresterhill Road from **9pm on 28 April to 7am on 29 April**.



Public Access (Car) ← - - - →

Members of the public who need to access the Emergency Department should use the Maggie's Centre entrance on Westburn Road or Cornhill Road entrances. There will be emergency parking in an area of the RACH car park. Please see map, which indicates the location of drop off, parking and the walking route to the ED entrance.

Pedestrian Access —————

The footpath leading from Foresterhill Road to and from ED and RACH will be closed, please see map for alternative route.

All Staff

Please be advised that you should not park in the RACH car park overnight and should instead use the Lady Helen Parking Centre on Foresterhill Road. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this essential work.
