

Judith Proctor, Chief Officer - Moray Health and Social Care Partnership

Judith has worked in health and social care for over 30 years, having started her post university career as a nurse in Edinburgh before working as a district nurse and midwife in the Highlands and in Shetland. She was one of the first Public Health Practitioners in Scotland, working in Dumfries and Galloway and completed her Masters in Public Health at Glasgow University. Following a secondment to the Scottish Executive to work on the implementation of community planning across Scotland, she then moved into a Joint Health Board / Local Authority role in planning and commissioning becoming the Director of Strategic Planning and Commissioning for health and social care in Dumfries and Galloway.

In 2016, she became the first Chief Officer of the Aberdeen City Health and Social Care Partnership before going on to lead the Edinburgh Health and Social Care Partnership as its Chief Officer for five years.

She was appointed Chief Officer of Health & Social Care Moray in November 2024, having served as Interim Chief Officer for five months.
