- Maternity Charter of Rights & Responsibilities launched 22nd August along with 4 translated versions, upload to Badgernet and the BiG website [Moray Maternity – Birth in Grampian \(scot.nhs.uk\)](https://www.scot.nhs.uk/moray-maternity-birth-in-grampian/)
- Grampian Perinatal and Infant Mental Health Collaborative set up and met for first time 12th Sept

- SLWGs with lived experience input underway for review of Mental Health & Wellbeing and Infant Feeding tabs on BiG website
- New fertility website engagement being taken forward by service
